ARCHIVES

Many branches have disbanded for various reasons, and thought must be given to their archives, and the storage thereof. The question of what archival material consists of has been posed to us several times. The following list may be used as a guideline: Minute Books; Financial Ledgers; pertinent correspondence; photos of special events; speeches/reports written by branch members; as well as any publications produced by the branch. According to our Constitution, Archives from disbanded branches should be sent in to the National Office.

We have had questions regarding the “prapory”, or banners. These can be kept, as they are used when a member falls asleep in the Lord. However, they must be kept in a place where they are treated with respect, usually the church or church hall. We will be sending an informational letter to disbanded branches regarding their archives.

UKRAINIAN VOICE

We just received a Memo from the president of the Ukrainian Voice reminding us that 2010 marks the 100th Anniversary of the publication. We are enclosing this memo with this newsletter for your attention and consideration. Let me just add that “Ukrainskiy Holos” played a very important role in the growth and development of all our Ukrainian Institutions. It was part of the “glue” that held us together by keeping us informed and united. As a child growing up in a small community, I remember, as many of you do as well, the Holos coming into our home, and how much my parents looked forward to receiving it.
